#### ANCIENT HISTORY

The Levant was the cradle of the grape. The Canaanites, Egyptians, Phoenicians, Israelites, Greeks and Romans all contributed to making the Eastern Mediterranean the place where wine culture was born and developed.

500-700 CE Nabateans create successful Negev wine industry.
650 CE Muslim period. Decline of wine production.

1200-1800 CE Domestic winemaking only, by Jews and Christians.1200 CE Crusaders take Holy Land vines back to Europe.

#### **MODERN HISTORY**

The founding of the modern Israel wine industry by Baron Edmond de Rothschild used French expertise.

1839	Sir Moses Montefiore urged Jews to return to agriculture & plant vines.
1 X 3 U	Sir Moses Montenore iirged lews to return to agriculture & night vines

Ginio Winery founded in Old City of Jerusalem.

Shor family founds winery in Old City (Zion Winery.) OLDEST EXISTING WINERY.

Moses Montefiore purchased the first land to encourage agriculture.

1870 Mikveh Israel Agricultural School opened.

Teperberg founded in Jerusalem.

Founding of Templar winery at Sarona.

Baron Edmond de Rothschild (Ch. Lafite) founded Carmel. ISRAEL WINE INDUSTRY.

1890-92 Rishon Le Zion & Zichron Ya'acov Cellars built.
